

## **INFLIBNET Centre Projects and Services for Higher Education Institutions: An Analytical Study**

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### **Abstract:**

*Information and Communication Technology is a driving force in the contemporary higher education system. The INFLIBNET Centre has taken up several initiatives for the benefit of the academic community in India. With the support of MHRD and UGC the INFLIBNET Centre conducting many projects for the academic community. In this article, the author identifies 30 projects initiated by the INFLIBNET Centre not only for library and information science professionals/users but also for other disciplines professionals as well as other users. As per the study; out of 30 projects, 9 projects are free access, 19 projects access through institutional membership access and only one commercial project that is SOUL software for library professionals. This article also highlights the statistics of the specific project. The development process and the current status of the projects also highlight in this article. The author also highlights the subject coverage as well as the type of resources/services available on the specific project undertaken by the INFLIBNET Centre. Overall this article focuses on the academic communities like faculty, researchers, students, and other users how to use/access this type of project for their day-to-day activities.*

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### **I. INTRODUCTION**

In April 1988, the University Grant Commission (UGC) constituted a committee under the chairmanship of Prof. Yash Pal, to work out the details of a University Information Library Networking System. The main aim of the Centre is Computer Communication Network of Libraries and Information Centres of Universities, Institutions of National Importance, R&D Institutions, Bibliographical Information Centres, etc, thereby improving the capability in information handling and services in India. The INFLIBNET Centre is an autonomous Inter-University Centre of the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India under the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) located in Gandhinagar, Gujarat. The centre was initially started as a national project (INFLIBNET Programme) under the Inter-University Centre of the Astronomy and Astrophysics (IUCAA) in March 1991 at Gujarat University Guest House, Ahmedabad. It became an independent Inter-University Centre of UGC in June 1996. (Wikipedia, 2020 & INFLIBNET, 2021). The INFLIBNET Centre engaging many projects and services under the MHRD guidelines of central government and some of the important projects and consultancy services details are provided in this study.

### **II. REVIEW OF LITERATURE**

Many investigators did their work in INFLIBNET Centres projects and services related for the academic community. Some of the relevant articles collected from the ShodhGanga, e-ShodhSindhu, INFLIBNET website, Google Scholar, and other websites. More than fifty articles collected for this study, few relevant articles reviewed, and the result shown below;

Chandrakar & Arora (2011) focus on their article entitled Initiative of the INFLIBNET Centre for Delivering Information to the Indian Academic Community that Dr. S R Ranganathan five laws and delivery of information services for the end-users. The establishment of the INFLIBNET Centre, an autonomous IUC of UGC located at Ahmedabad as a nodal agency for academic institutions like universities, national importance centres, and colleges within India. They also elaborate on various initiatives of the Centre taken for delivering the information to the academic community of the country. And also highlights the impact of the initiatives on higher education of the country.

Deivam (2016) highlights the status of INFLIBNET centre and information and communication technology initiatives in India. The national program on technology-enabled learning, Gyankosh, Sakshat, Institute of Life Long Learning, GyanKosh, e-PGPathshala, and Shodhganga, etc.

Madaan & Dhingra (2013) highlights the concept of consortia and the factors which led to the development of 'Consortia Based subscriptions'. They discuss various existing consortia like UGC-INFONET, INDEST Consortium, Consortia for e-resources in Agriculture (CeRA), FORSA Library Consortia, and Health Sciences Library and Information Science Network (HELINET).

The concept of N-List has been developed to accelerate the research work. Research articles, journals, books, etc. are available electronically through the N-LIST. One can also read and store electronic information in the N-List. This article aims to create awareness among researchers, students & also higher education institutes about why should use the N-LIST (Ramesh & Rajendra, 2018)

Pradhan (2018) study the Central University of Orissa is getting 8500+ e-journals from e ShodhSindhu consortia of INFLIBNET. To assess the usage of these e-journals by the users of the Central University of Orissa, the author analyzed the statistics using INFISTAT of INFLIBNET. It was found that certain resources are being utilized more by the users, which reflects the popularity of the journals as well as the publisher. The study also shows the trend and statistics of usage by month, by year, by databases, and by journals, etc.

- to concentrate on the subject coverage and resource forms offered in the specified projects
- to learn about the project's access kind, phenomenon, and statistics

### **IV. METHODOLOGY**

The Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre is MHRD project was called stated in the year 1991 under the leadership of Prof. Yashpal. The importance of this article is to analyse and find out the significant projects handled by INFLIBNET Centre for higher education Community. The data were collected from the INFLIBNET, UGC, and other MHRD related Website for this study in the month of July to November 2021 and presented in the analysis part (INFLIBNET, 2021).

### **V. DATA ANALYSIS AND FINDINGS**

Despite of providing valuable resources and services for their end users; INFLIBNET centre also provides the additional projects and consultancy services to them, in order to improve the quality of services to the end users. The study highlights the different projects initiated by the INFLIBNET Centre under the support of UGC MHRD.

The Figure 1 shows that the INFLIBNET Centre provide Phenomenon wise different project and consultancy services to their end users (INFLIBNET, 2020).

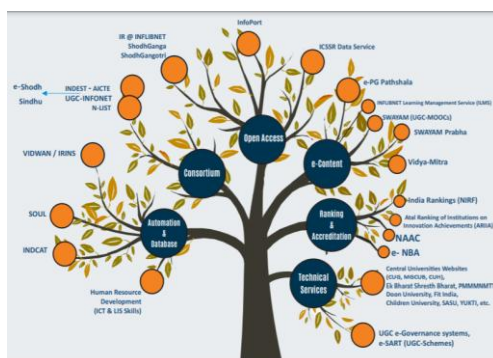









Figure – 1: INFLIBNET Projects and Consultancies

Table 2 represents the subject coverage in the different projects and consultant services. Table 3 details the access type for 30 projects and consultancy services offered by the INFLIBNET Centre. We can identify that, 19 are institutional membership based access, 9 are free access, and 1 commercial access project of SOUL software. The books, theses and serials union catalogue of the IndCat and the automation of libraries related SOUL Software are the major 2 projects initiated by the INFLIBNET Centre for library automation. Table 4 also provides information such as there are in total 15631855 records of books database from 200 universities, 35234 records of serials database from 229 Universities and 441393 records of Theses database from 444 Universities in IndCat databases. The Software for University Libraries (SOUL) software installed in 3800 institutions.

Another project is IRINS all the subject expert profile and their status is available in this database. The Table 7 highlights the status of the two scholarly network or expert databases.

The five E-Content Development and Services projects undertaken by the INFLIBNET Centre for the benefit of academic users are shown in Table 8. All of the projects are associated with e-learning and e-training. The UGC, NCERT, CEC, NPTEL, IGNOU, NIOS are UGC MOOC supported projects. According to current trends, online courses are quite important, and the five projects are also beneficial to the learners.
