When she was only ten, she had a vision of Jesus scourged and hanging on the cross and heard him say, "Look at me, my daughter." In sorrow, she asked him who had treated him like this.Jesus answered, "Those who despise me and refuse my love for them." All of Bridget's revelations on the sufferings of Jesus were published after her death. Bridget died in Rome on July 23, 1373. She was proclaimed a Saint by Pope Boniface IX in 1391. Out of her immense love for Christ's Passion, which she had since childhood, St.Bridget prayed for a long time sincerely wanting to know how many wounds Jesus had suffered during His terrible Passion. Rewarding her patience, one day while St.Bridget was praying in the Church of St.Paul in Rome, Jesus appeared to her and said, "I received 5480 Wounds upon My Body. If you wish to honor them in some way, recite fifteen Our Fathers and fifteen Hail Marys' with the following Prayers, which I Myself shall teach you. Do this each day for an entire year. When the year is finished, you will have honored each of My Wounds.". There are 15 prayers of St Bridget. Some lines of the first prayer are 'Remember that You were despoiled of Your garments and clothed in those of mockery, was battered, crowned with thorns, a reed placed in Your Hands, that You were crushed with blows and overwhelmed with insults and outrages.'

**Prayers of St Dymphna**<sup>2</sup> Dymphna was born in Ireland sometime in the seventh century to a pagan father and devout Christian mother. When she was fourteen, she consecrated herself to Christ and took a vow of chastity. Soon afterward, her mother died and her father - who had loved his wife deeply - began to suffer a rapid deterioration of his mental stability. Her father's evil advisors suggested to him to marry his own daughter. When she heard of her father's misguided plot, Dymphna fled her castle with her confessor, a priest named Gerebran, two trusted servants, and the king's fool. The group sailed toward what is now called Belgium, and hid in the town of Geel. They were later found and murdered by her father. In defense of her purity, Dymphna received the crown of martyrdom around the year 620 and became known as the "Lily of Éire.S Dymphna is often portrayed holding a Sword in one hand.
